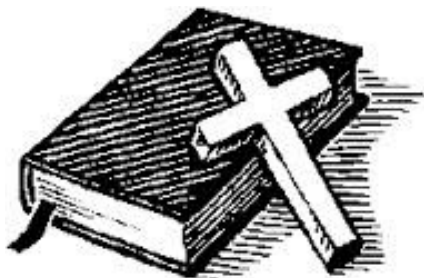
He was a graduate of Central High School in Winston-Salem and was of the Baptist faith.
