OBITUARY

Mr. Victor Lawrence was born to the late Charles William Lawrence and Clara Beatrice Beckham Lawrence in Chester, South Carolina, on December 6, 1940.

He began his early childhood education in the public schools of Charlotte/ Mecklenburg. When the family relocated to Winston-Salem, North Carolina, Vincent attended and graduated from Atkins High School, in 1958. Following high school graduation, he enrolled at NC Agricultural and Technical State University where he earned a degree in Automotive Mechanics.

Mr. Lawrence was a member of Mount Pleasant Missionary Baptist Church for over fifty years and he faithfully served with the Trustee, Chapel Choir and Boy Scout ministries of the church.

He was a member of the Winston-Salem Sportsman's Club, an avid golfer and a serious fan of the Washington Redskins and Carolina Panthers Football Teams. He was also a supportive and very active participant with the Parkinson Association.

Mr. Lawrence was one of the first African American supervisors at R. J. Reynolds Tobacco Company. He supervised employees at plant #8 and worked in Quality Assurance. He retired after thirty years of dedicated service to the company.

Victor Lawrence peacefully passed away from Forsyth Medical Center in Winston-Salem, North Carolina on Sunday, January 3, 2016, following a period of illness. In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by a brother, Charles William Lawrence, Jr.
