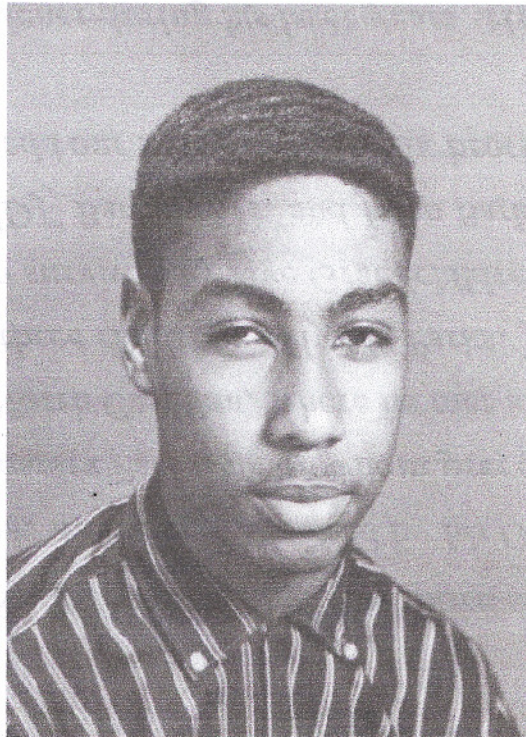

Biography of A Good Man
