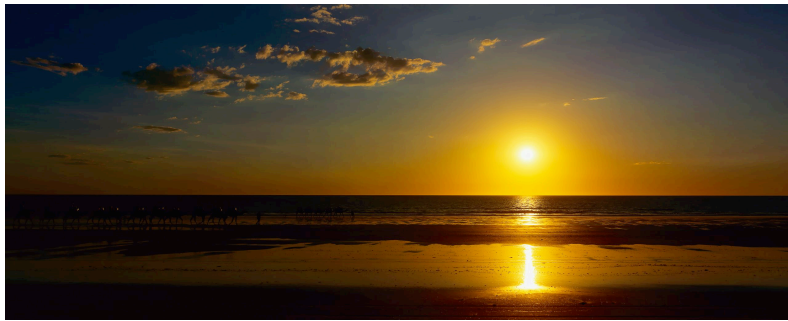


When our time on Earth has ended
